

HIGHLIGHTS OF LAKEHEAD UNIVERSITY'S ECONOMIC IMPACT ON THE CITIES OF THUNDER BAY AND ORILLIA

\$306.7 Million *	The total economic impact of Lakehead University on Thunder Bay and Orillia (with multiplier of 2.14 x operating expenditures).
\$143.3 Million *	Total operating expenditures of Lakehead in 2009/10 (including operations, capital, research and scholarships and bursaries).
2,000 Employees	Lakehead University is a major employer in the City of Thunder Bay. This includes approximately 780 full-time positions.
\$86.6 Million *	Salaries and benefits paid by Lakehead University in 2009/10.
\$7.2 Million *	Monthly payroll.
8,613 Students	Total number of students enrolled at Lakehead University. This includes 7,015 full-time graduate and undergraduate students.
4,910 Students	Approximately 70 % of full-time students attending Lakehead University are from outside the local commuting area.
\$89.9 Million	New money brought into Thunder Bay and Orillia by students from outside the local commuting area.
\$0.52 Million *	Paid by Lakehead University to Thunder Bay and Orillia in lieu of taxes.
\$16.4 Million *	Research support received by Lakehead University.
\$8.0 Million *	Paid to students this year in scholarships, bursaries and awards.
